## PETITION FOR CITIZENSHIP

To the Honorable the District Court of United States at Los Angeles, Calif.  
 The petition of EMILIO FRANCISCO XAVIER DANENBERG hereby filed, respectfully shown  
 (1) My place of residence is 114 Queen Anne Pl., Los Angeles, Calif. my occupation is Professor of Music  
 (2) I was born in Hong Kong, China on Jan. 10, 1877 My race is Danish  
 (4) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on Jan. 21, 1929 in the District  
 Court of United States at Los Angeles, Calif.  
 (5) I am married. The name of my wife is Herailia Hong Kong, China <sup>he was</sup>  
 we were married on June 27, 1916 at Hong Kong, China ; entered the United States  
 born at Hong Kong, China on August 15, 1897 at San Francisco, Calif. April 1 - 1928 for permanent residence therein, and now  
 resides at with me I have 2 children, and the name, date,  
 and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows:  
Emil - July 30, 1917; Gertrude - August 20, 1918; both born Hong Kong, China.  
Both reside with me.

COURT OF RECORD

(6) My last foreign residence was a couple months ago, when I emigrated to the United States of America from Hong Kong, China. My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at San Francisco, Calif. under the name of E. F. X. Danenbergen <sup>crossed out to</sup> Siberia Maru on Oct. 15, 1926 on the vessel <sup>crossed out to</sup> China as shown by the certificate of arrival attached hereto and made a part of this petition. I do solemnly swear and declare that I did not (and do not) hold or have a direct or indirect interest in (or (7) I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons who believe in or support the principles set forth in the Constitution of the United States to govern and governmennt, and I do not and have not ever been a member of any organization or body of persons who do not believe in or support the principles set forth in the Constitution of the United States, and I do not and have not ever given or promised to any organization or body of persons who do not believe in or support the principles set forth in the Constitution of the United States, it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to England, Germany, Austria, Portugal, Spain, Italy, France, Russia, Belgium, Denmark, Netherlands, Switzerland, Scandinavia, Scotland, Ireland, and the British Dominions beyond the Seas, of whom (which) at this time I am a subject or citizen, and I do so declare before God and the world.

(8) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since Oct. 15, 1926 and in the County of Los Angeles this State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since Oct. 30, 1926 being a resident within said county of at least six months next preceding the date of this petition.

(10) I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship; Number on and such petition was denied by that Court for the following reasons and cause, to wit:

 (11) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since my said arrival, and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses required by law, <sup>and I do solemnly swear and declare to the best of my knowledge and belief, and that as to those matters I believe it to be true, and that this petition is signed by me with my full, true name.</sup>  
 Wherefore, I, your petitioner, pray that I may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.

I, your above-named petitioner being duly sworn, depose and say that I have <sup>read</sup> <sup>and understood</sup> this petition and know the contents thereof, that the same is true of my own knowledge except as to matters herein stated to be alleged upon information and belief, and that as to those matters I believe it to be true, and that this petition is signed by me with my full, true name.
